## GRINNERS ARE WINNERS

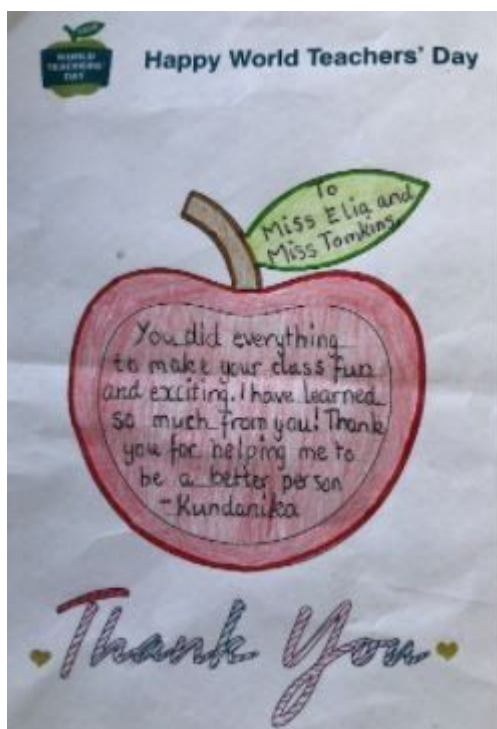
Congratulations to **2A** for consistently being safe, responsible and respectful in class last week. A perfect score!!
